Before submitting your name, please make sure that you answer the questions foreseen in **the Act on elections and referendums in municipalities**. Certain dispositions could hinder you to submit your name, for example, if you are already working elections in another municipality.

According to article 69 of **the Act on elections and referendums in municipalities** “A person is not qualified to hold office as an election officer of any municipality if that person has been convicted of an offence constituting a fraudulent electoral practise within the meaning of section 645 of the Act respecting school elections (chapter E-2.3) or the Election Act (chapter E-3.3)”.
