### **High-speed Internet Committee**

The High-Speed Internet Committee is presently looking to fill a few vacant positions.

An experience in the field of high-speed internet is highly recommended. Thus, the committee has the power to make studies and recommendations on High Speed Internet accessibility. They are accountable to the Council.

The committee is composed of a Councillor and a maximum of four citizens. The term of office is two years and is not renewable. The nominations will be made by resolution at the Municipal Council meeting due to take place June 6<sup>th</sup> 2016.

The High Speed Internet Committee is formed by the Municipal Council to facilitate a comprehensive review of High Speed Internet accessibility in the municipality. Its aim is to improve the methods of accessing High Speed Internet in order to improve the quality of life of the citizens. Protection of the environment should always be at the heart of decisions. The Committee shall evaluate the issues that are brought to its attention by the citizens in position, the Council or the Director General.

All members of the committee are voting members. The Councillor preside over the meetings. To make a decision, the councillor and 50% +1 of the voting members must be present. Decisions must be passed by 50% +1 of the present voting members to be adopted. The Municipal Council may also appoint to the committee someone whose services may be required for its functions. The Council may vote and supply to the Committee the money it may require to perform its functions.
